

# *YOUTHJET IS NOW SEEKING EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST IN ENROLLING INTO VOCATIONAL STUDIES A & B*

*As of Term 1 2010, YouthJET will offer all schools the opportunity to enrol individual students into Stage 2 Vocational Studies A & B. YouthJET will arrange all theory and practical work and assessments, work placements and VET brokerage. Vocational Studies A & B each count as two full year SACE Units.*

## **WHAT STUDENTS WOULD BE APPROPRIATE?**

- Students who are at risk of not completing the SACE pattern requirements.
- Students who have non-academic talents and have limited choices.
- Students that prefer a more hands on style.
- Students that have limited subject options.
- Students involved in school based apprentices or traineeships.

## **WHAT IS VOCATIONAL STUDIES?**

Vocational Studies aims to develop student understanding of the world of work and to assist students to develop the knowledge, skills, competencies and attributes appropriate to the work environment. Students are provided with opportunities to explore vocations of choice through theoretical study and practical application in the workplace. Importantly, this subject assists students to plan and prepare for their transition from secondary education to further education, training or employment. Students of Vocational Studies undertake vocational education and training (VET) in an industry area of choice. This may be with a Registered Training Provided (RTO) or as part of an Australian School Based Traineeship or Apprenticeship.

## **WHO WILL RUN THE COURSE?**

This course will be run at YouthJET by a registered teacher holding a Masters in counselling with over 20 years experience working within schools with the Vocational and VET System. She is considered an expert in helping students obtain SACE when they may not have otherwise been able to.

## **THE FORMAT FOR THIS COURSE WILL BE:**

- A two day induction and overview session at YouthJET on Hutt Street at the start of the term.
- Individual Career counselling to assess what work and VET placement would be of most interest and benefit for the student.
- Ongoing work with the students to arrange all VET Courses and Work placement.
- Ongoing monitoring, follow up and evaluation of these placements with the students.
- Ongoing individual and group follow ups with students to ensure that all written material is completed.
- A closing session of one or two days to finalise the course and insure all assessments are met.
